**POSITION SUMMARY:**

As a valued member of our team, the Certified Nursing Assistant (C.N.A.) works to provide assistance with activities of daily living in a day services program for physically/cognitively impaired older adults.

**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Coordinate and provide participants with assistance in activities of daily living, including transfers, ambulation, eating, and toileting
- Assist in participant supervision
- Observe and report changes in participant status
- Assist other staff in meal and snack serving
- Practice environmental safety and sanitation
- Help to maintain a welcoming, cheerful and protective environment for program participants
- Communicate on a one-to-one basis with participants
- Maintain confidentiality
- Within scope of practice, assist Rosener House Nurse in monitoring heights, weights, vital signs
- Assist therapists as needed
- Assist with providing special diets, and under direction of Speech Therapist, Nurse and/or Occupational Therapist assist with feeding and cueing specific participants
- Be trained and prepared to implement emergency procedures for group or individuals
- Provide input on participants for team meetings
- Other duties as needed

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Energetic and a team player with enthusiasm for working with older adults
- Training and experience in working with impaired elders
- Skill, physical ability, and education in providing personal care assistance and transfers
- Skill in communicating with participants
- Ability to follow written and oral directions
- Good work ethic, reliable and punctual
- Ability to work as part of interdisciplinary team
- Good physical health as verified by a health screening, including negative test results for tuberculosis
- CPR/First Aid certified
- California Dept. of Social Services and Dept. of Justice criminal record clearance required prior to employment

**PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- Able to occasionally lift up to fifty pounds while assisting participants

- Regularly required to walk, stand, bend, stoop, twist, kneel, reach, carry
- Frequently required to push wheelchairs
- Fitness for duty exam required

STATUS: On-Call; non-exempt/hourly

HOURS: Monday-Friday generally between 8:30-4:30 as needed
